# ACHIEVEMENTS

## **CCS District Mental Health Team**

Reviewed and responded over 40 student mental health referrals to ensure appropriate service alignment.

## **Research Triangle Institute Subaward**

Support our efforts to assess and strengthen evidence-based practices that improve school climate and student well-being.

## **Completion of Alcohol, Nicotine, Cannabis & Other Drug Curriculum**

Provide students with accurate, developmentally appropriate education on alcohol, nicotine, cannabis, and other drugs

## **Piedmont Health Services - Mobile Health Unit (Dental Services)**

Brought preventive and urgent dental care services directly to students during the school day (54 referrals, 6 visits between two schools)

## **Safe Routes to School**

Promote active transportation while teaching students essential skills for safely navigating their communities



# ACHIEVEMENTS

## **Duke Health Literacy Study**

supported data collection to better understand and address health literacy challenges among high school students.

## **Nutrition Literacy Staff Development**

Developed information and tools to integrate nutrition concepts into classroom instruction and promote healthy habits among students.

## **2025 Youth Risk Behavior Survey Administration**

Supported the gathering of critical data on student health behaviors to inform district planning and support services.

## **School Health Advisory Council**

Led collaborative efforts between school staff, families, and community partners to improve student health outcomes through policy and program recommendations.

## **CCS Triennial Assessment**

Assessed the district's compliance with federal wellness policy requirements and identified opportunities to enhance student health initiatives.
