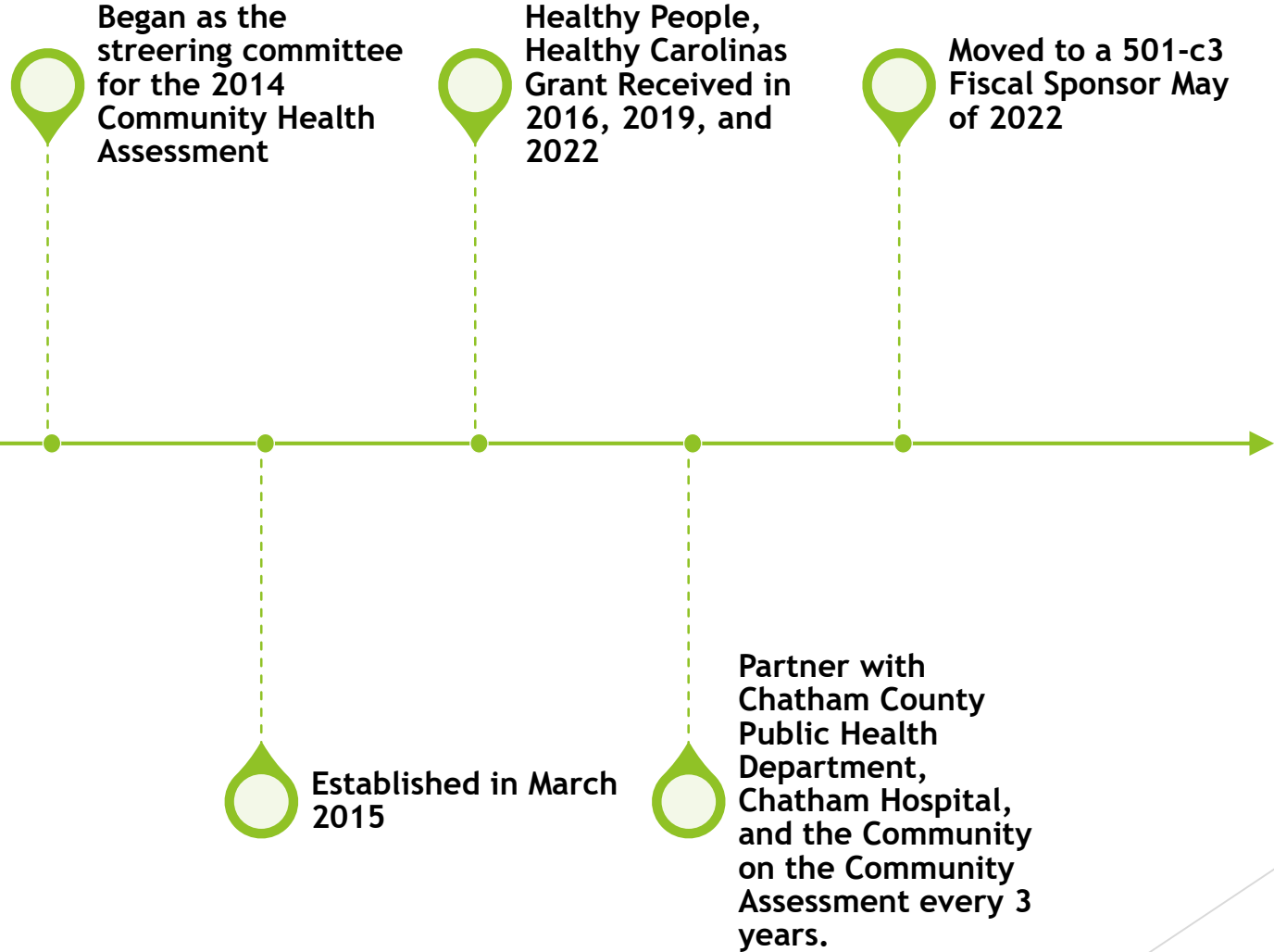


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# Vision & Mission

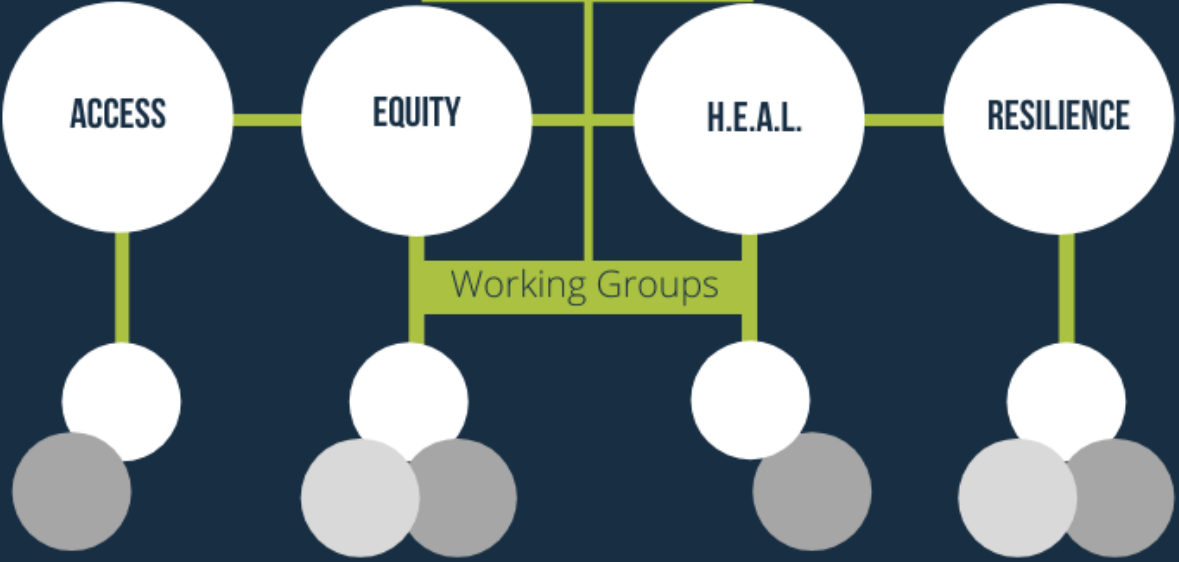

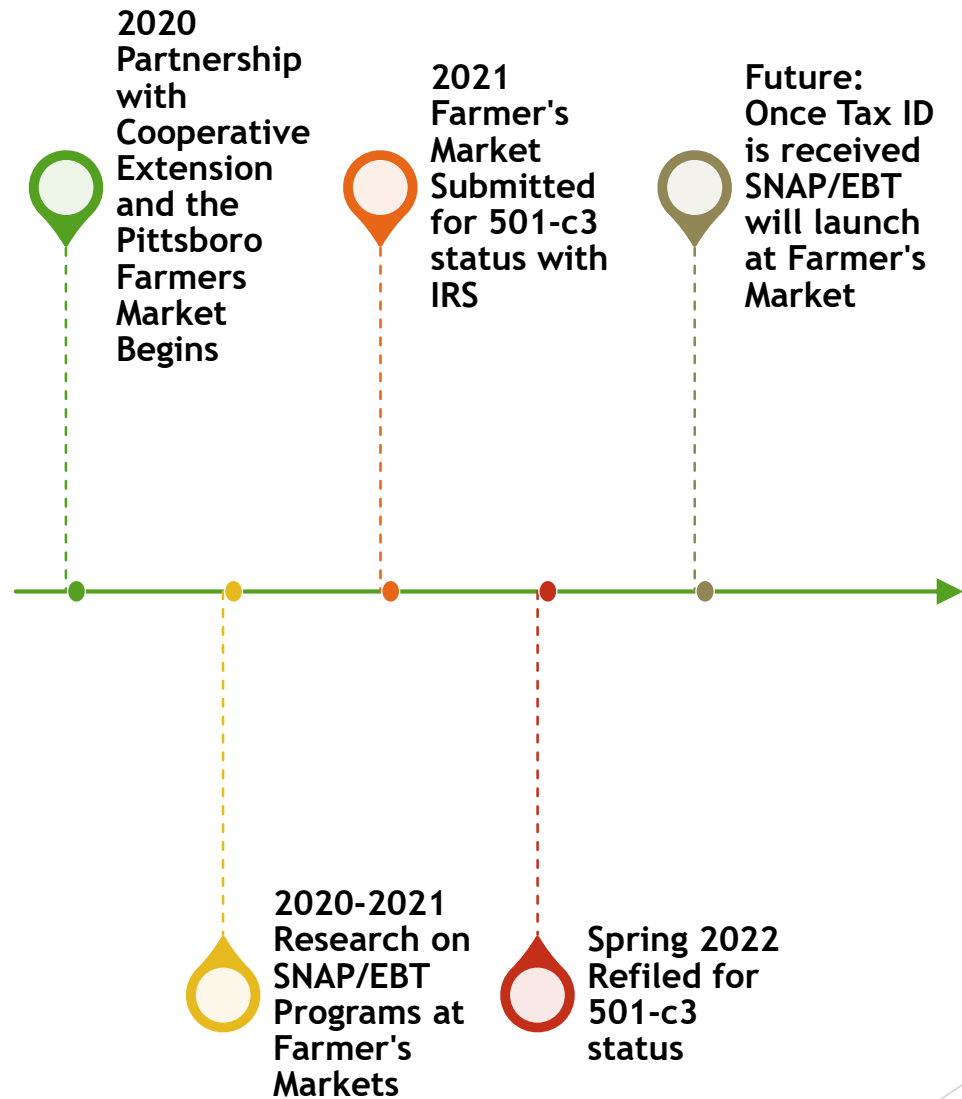


## NCCARE360 Pilot Project *Access Subcommittee*

## Community Resource Hub *Resilience Subcommittee*



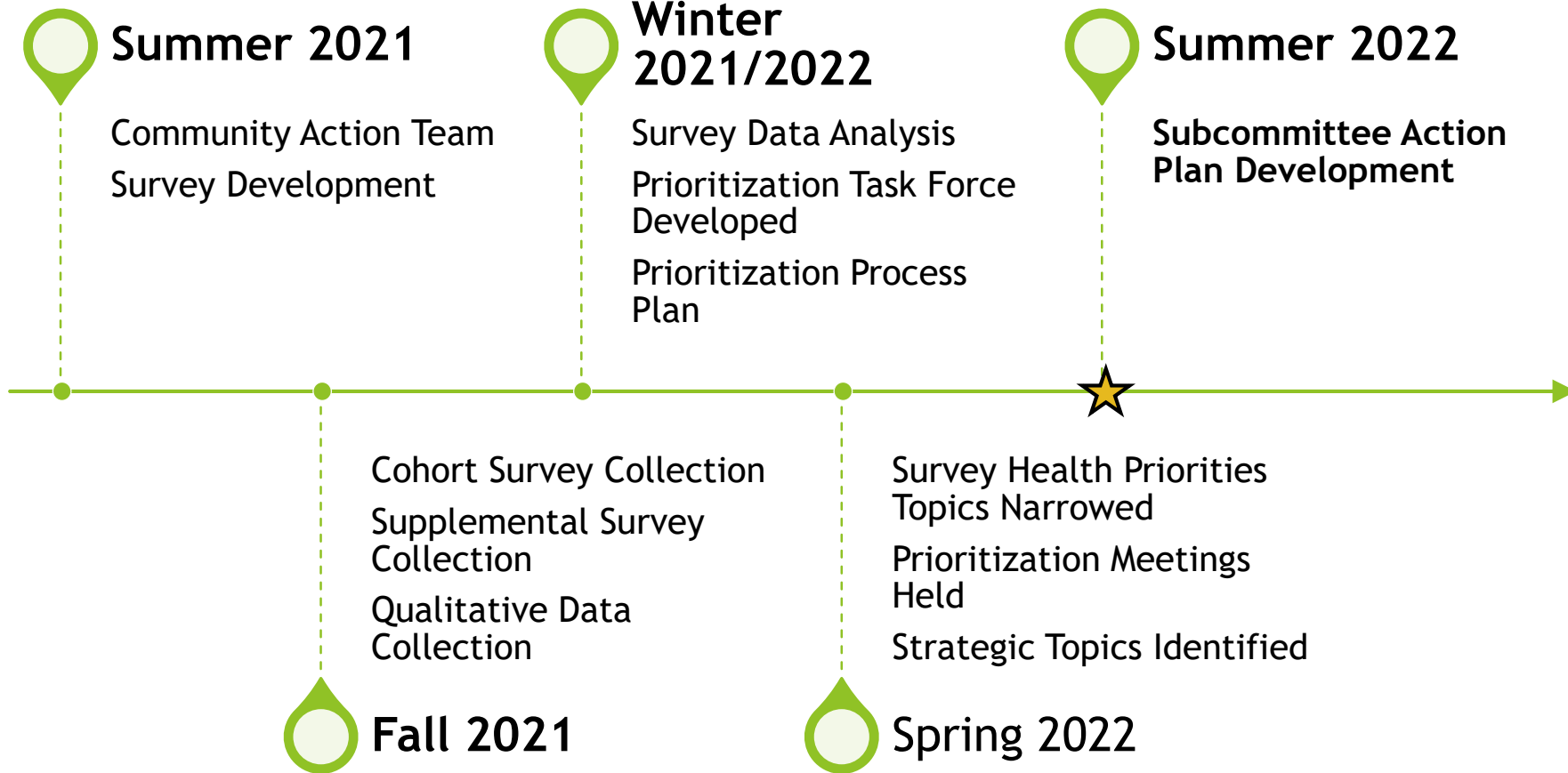

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## What is Prioritization?

The is a process of using qualitative and quantitative data from the Assessment process to identify the top health priorities that the Alliance will focus on over the next 3 years.

Planned the 2022 prioritization process

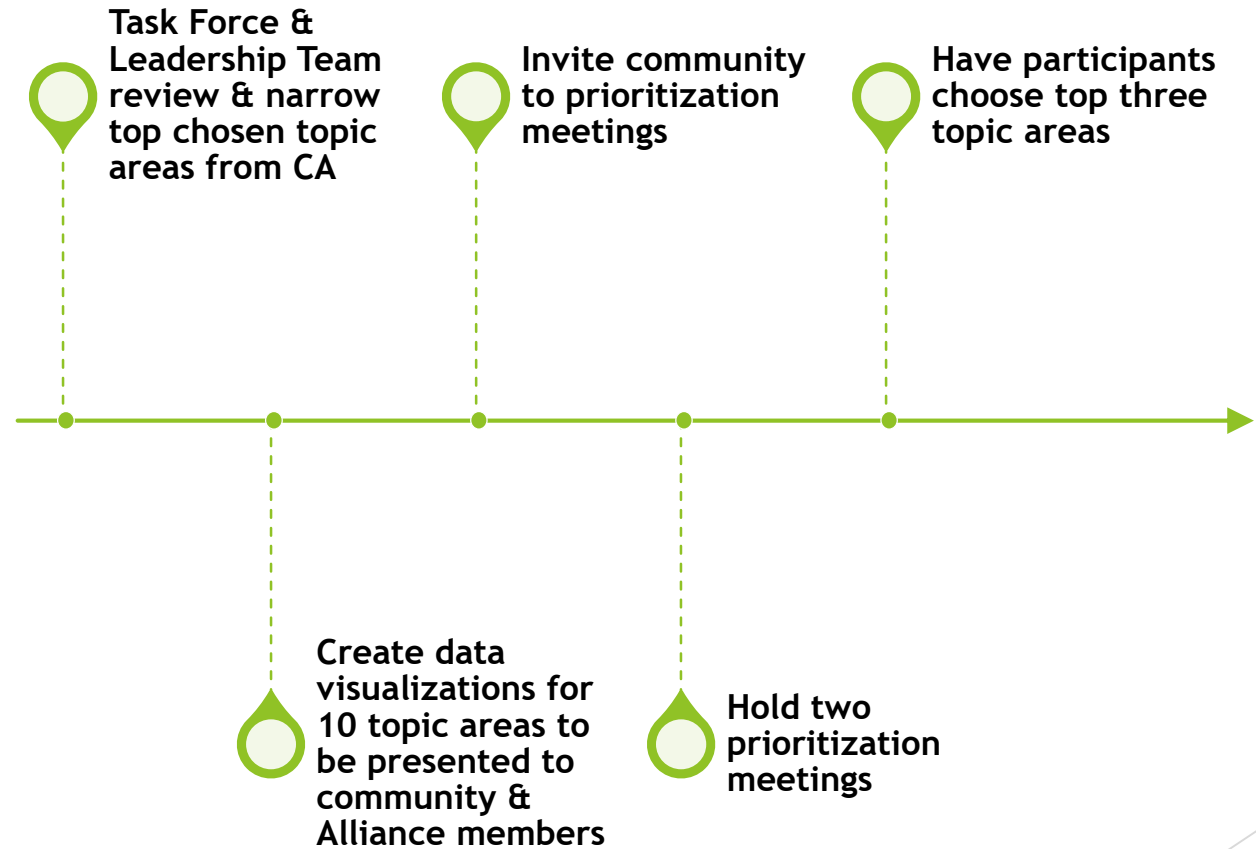
Brainstormed community engagement in prioritization process

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# Strategic Planning in Subcommittees

- ▶ Chatham Health Alliance strategic plans are three year plans that utilize Results Based Accountability to create living documents that inform the work and resource of the Alliance.
- ▶ Timeline of Strategic Planning
  - Facilitators for each subcommittee will take a Results Based Accountability training in by the end of June 2022
  - Facilitators will meet after the trainings to develop a plan
  - Alliance members will meet in July and August to develop their Subcommittee specific strategic action plan

# Outcomes of Strategic Planning

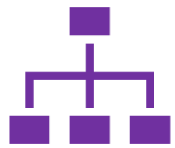
- ▶ Chatham Health Alliance strategic planning process will create goals, strategies, and metrics for each health priority using the identified health strategic topic areas.
