
Mission/vision, history & structure



A task force of Alliance members who came together to discuss using the Community Assessment to identify the Health Priorities for the next 3 years.


Developed 2022 health priority proposal

Strategic Planning in Subcommittees

Chatham Health Alliance strategic plans are three year plans that utilize Results Based Accountability to create living documents that inform the work and resource of the Alliance.

- Timeline of Strategic Planning
 - Facilitators for each subcommittee will take a Results Based Accountability training in by the end of June 2022
 - Facilitators will meet after the trainings to develop a plan
 - Alliance members will meet in July and August to develop their Subcommittee specific strategic action plan



Results Based Accountability

Data-driven, decision-making process.

Starts with ends and works backward, towards means.

Population accountability organizes our work with co-equal partners to promote community well-being.

Performance Accountability organizes our work to have the greatest impact on our customers. What we do for our customers is our contribution to community impact.
