Project Updates

DSS Emergency Household Assistance (EHAP) Program

- \$531,180 expended on participants through December 2025
- Currently using ARPA-enabled funds
- Program expense will require general fund support in FY 27

Hydrant Repair Project

- 60 hydrants are planned for replacement
- As of December 2025, the project is substantially complete
- Planned to repair 6-7 more hydrants due to the project coming in under-budget

Schools HVAC Project

- BOE approved contracts in September 2025
- Construction phase has begun – spending will increase as
