

COVID State and County Trends (as of 1/14/20)


North Carolina

- 650,926 people have tested positive for COVID
- 7,825 people have died of COVID
- Positivity Rate = 13%
- Rolling 7-day average has increased



Chatham County

- 3,245 people have tested positive for COVID
- 67 people have died of COVID
- Positivity Rate = 8.3%
- Rolling 7-day average has increased



Vaccine



- COVID-19 vaccine rolling out, supplies still limited

Internal Coronavirus Relief Fund Use

- Public Health & Medical Expenses (\$175,000):
 - Finishing all purchases of disinfectant, PPE, and any other safety needs
 - Distributing social distancing floor decals
 - Distributed Chatham County logo masks to employees
- Payroll Expenses (\$1,285,221.12):
 - Confirmed and reported
- Compliance Expenses (\$300,000):
 - Finalizing Chatham County mask requirement signage
 - Distributed items purchased to address teleworking needs expressed in the needs assessment
 - Purchased Zoom package for employees (will deploy once emails have been secured)

External Coronavirus Relief Fund Use

- Nonprofits (\$200,000):
 - Officially closed out
- Municipalities (\$726,740):
 - Officially closed out
- Economic Support (\$195,000):
 - Continued use of the housing support resources

Chatham Food Hub

Here's what you helped us achieve through the Food Hub:

- •Generated \$7,995.86 in revenues for local restaurants and farms
- •Paid over \$7,000.00 in wages to Chatham County residents
- Donated 862 servings of prepared food to Chatham County residents
- through local nonprofit and governmental partners
- •Distributed **220 CORA emergency food boxes** to 100 unique individuals
- Provided over 300 free cloth masks to Hub customers
