



Chatham Promise Proposed COVID-19 Exceptions

Extend credit-requirement exceptions to the graduating high school students whose academic records demonstrate that they were on schedule to complete the required course credits for eligibility pre-COVID-19.



Chatham Promise Proposed COVID-19 Exceptions Example

- A high school senior might have been enrolled in the 6 credits/2 courses this spring to earn eligibility but withdrew from 1 or both courses because of COVID-19 related issues.
- The College would investigate such high school seniors' CCCC transcripts to determine if the student was issued a withdrawal(s) for Spring 2020 semester courses.
- If the student was issued a withdrawal but would have otherwise earned the required 6 credits/2 courses this spring for Chatham Promise eligibility, the College would consider this particular student as having met the eligibility requirements.
- These exceptions would not be available to all graduating high school students; it would only be available to those who would have earned the required credits before they transitioned to learning-at-home in March.
