SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

This Second Amendment to the Agreement (this “Second Amendment”) is made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2025, by and between Chatham County, North Carolina, a body politic and corporate of the State of North Carolina (the “County”) and Champion Family Healthcare Services dba Keston Care (the “Contractor”). The County and the Contractor are sometimes referred to in this Amendment individually as a “Party” and collectively as the “Parties.”

RECITALS

- A. The Parties entered into a series of agreements, the last of which was effective November 19, 2024.
- B. The County has requested that the Term be amended to extend the Agreement to June 30, 2026.
- C. The Contractor has requested that Compensation be amended to reflect an hourly rate of \$28.00 and an amount for the extension not to exceed \$150,000.00.
- D. The Parties have agreed to amend the Agreement as requested.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and the conditions contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Term of Agreement is extended to June 30, 2026.
- 2. The Compensation is amended to reflect an hourly rate of \$28.00 and an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 for the extended term.

AGREEMENT TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT. Except for the amendments set forth, the original Agreement effective October 1, 2023, shall remain in full force and effect.
