# Public Engagement

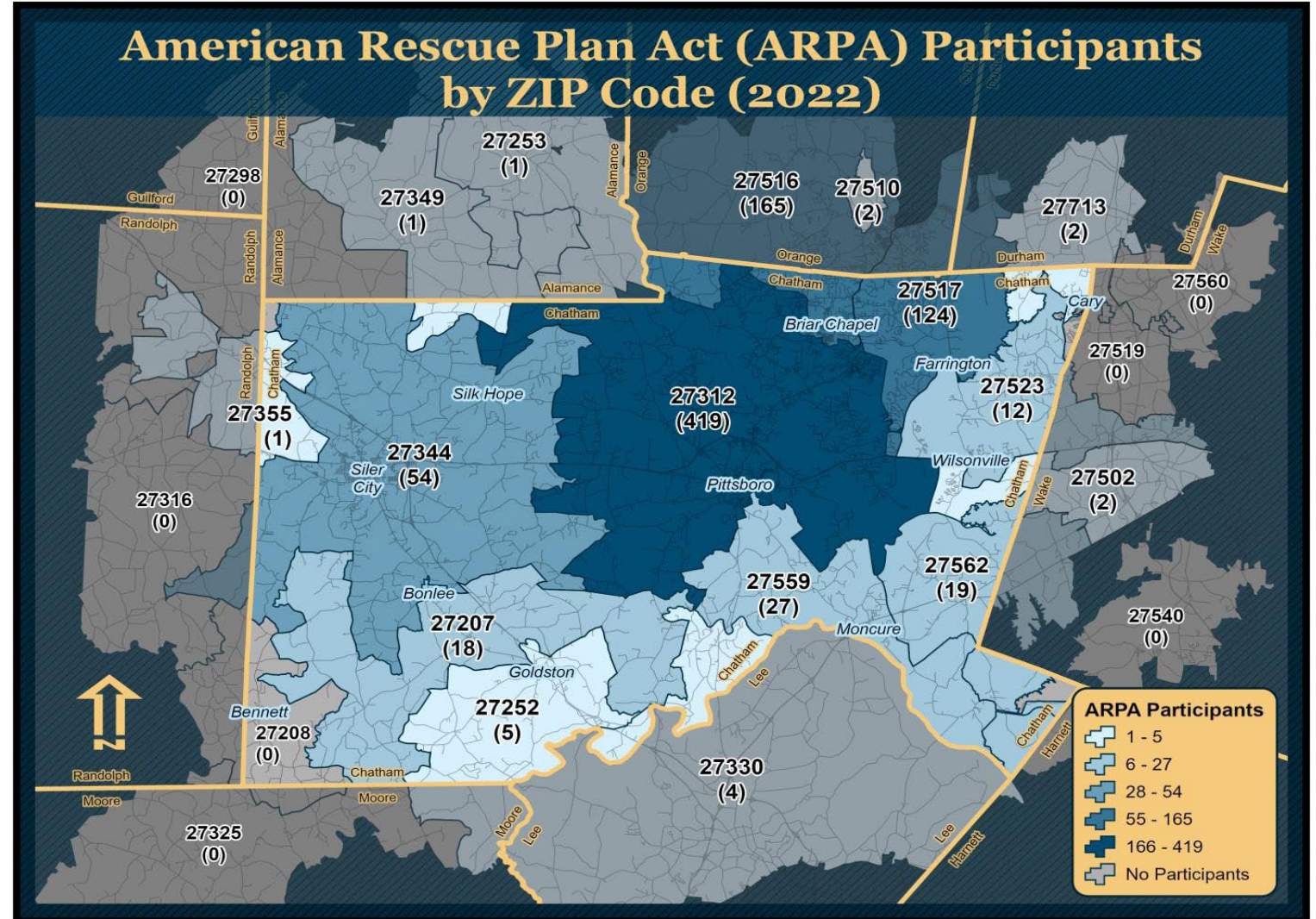
## Online Survey

- Survey results **reviewed and tagged by theme**

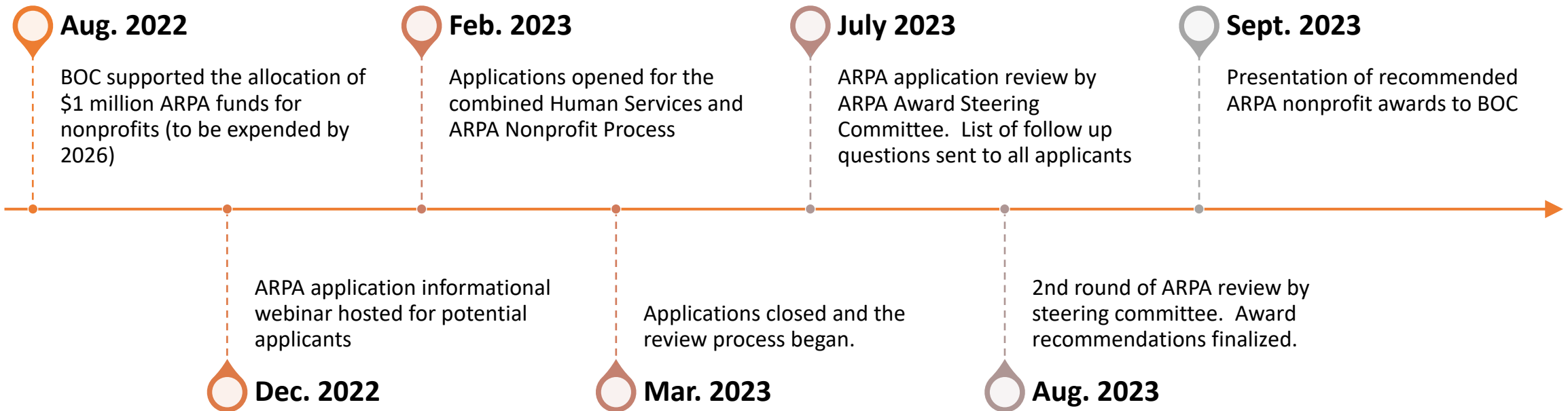
## Community Conversations

- **8 public engagement sessions** held across the county

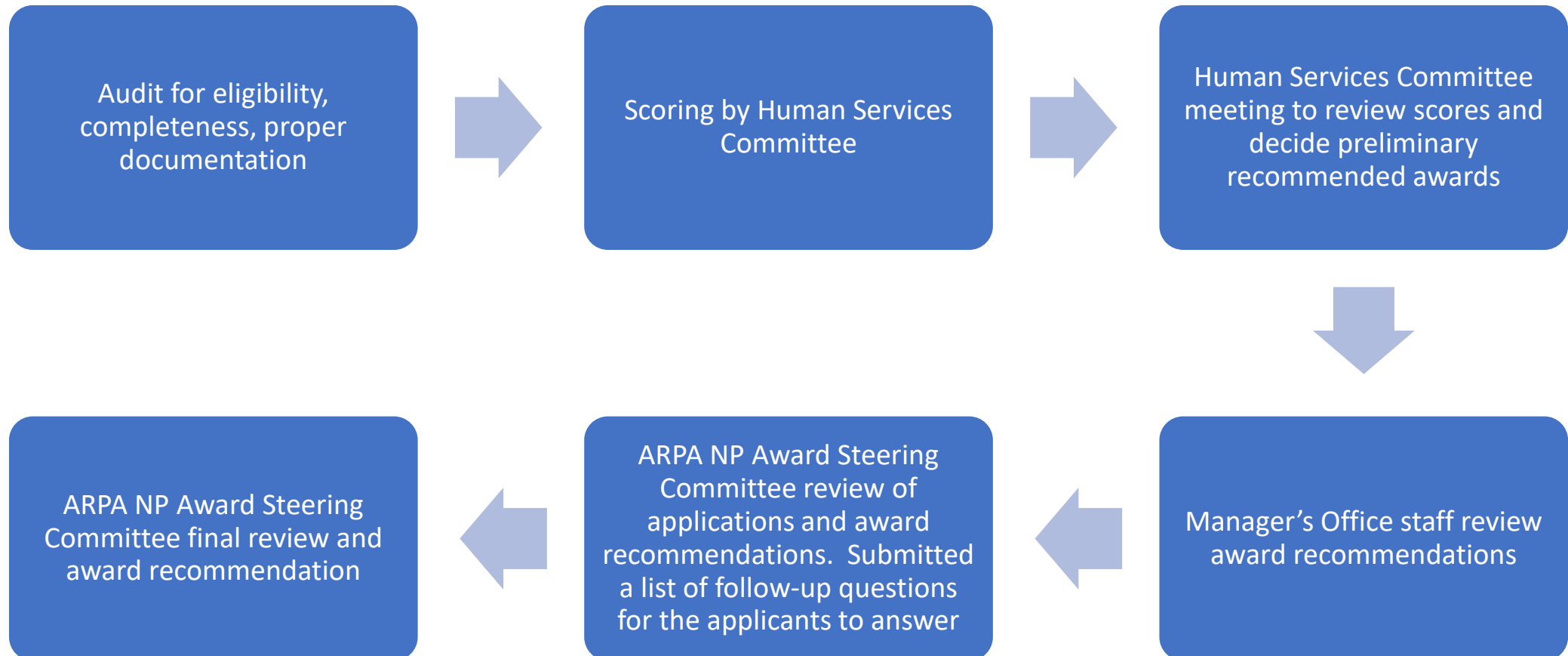
## Public Input at Board Meetings

Smaller award than 100% viable?

- All agencies had a plan for a less-than-100% award. No agency was a hard "all or nothing"

How is your program transformational or impactful?

- All programs individually- impactful
- Considered in total-*transformational*
