

### Public Engagement


#### **Online Survey**



• All agencies had considered how to sustain knowing the award will not repeat. Some very detailed, others had concepts or outlines of plans

#### Smaller award than 100% viable?

• All agencies had a plan for a less-than-100% award. No agency was a hard "all or nothing"

#### How is your program transformational or impactful?

- All programs individually- impactful
- Considered in total-transformational
