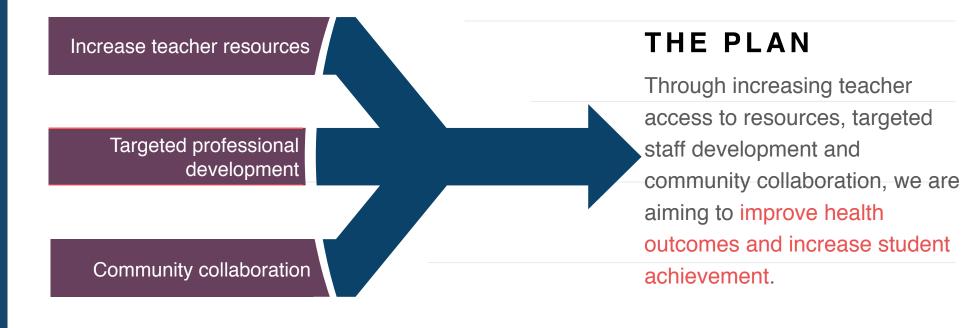
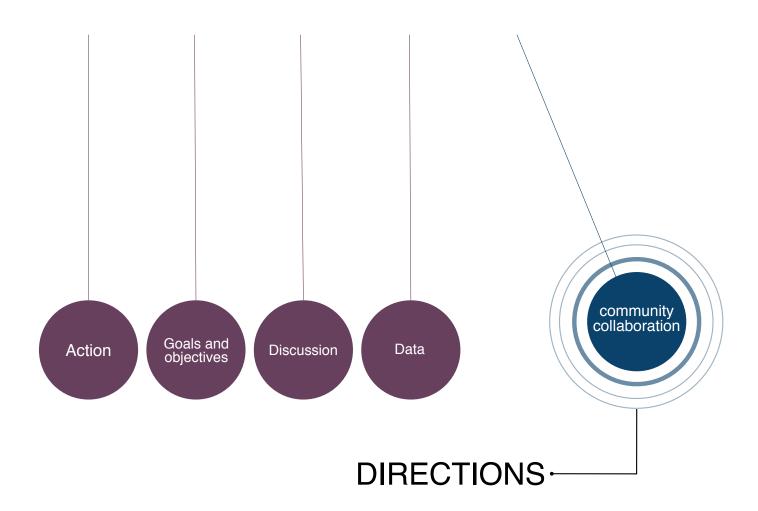

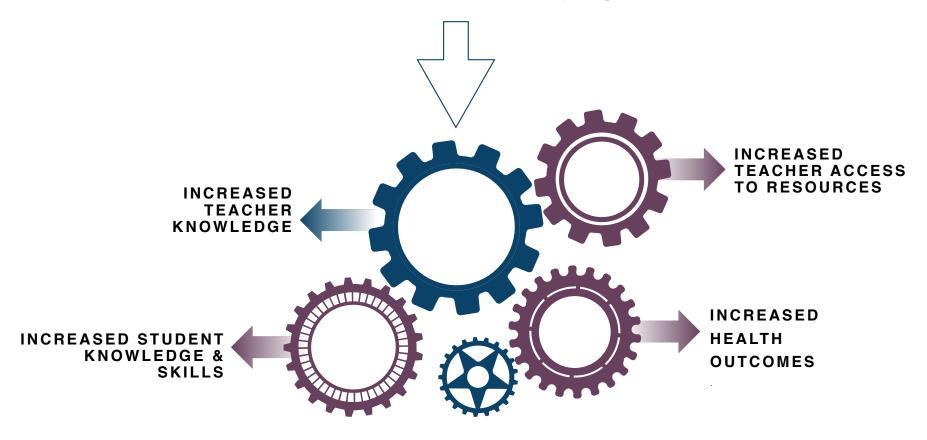
This initiative through the Department of Public Instruction is supporting us in developing healthier more academically successful students.
