Resolution of the Chatham County Board of Commissioners

Recognizing September 2026 as Healthy Aging Month in Chatham County

WHEREAS, Chatham County joins the state and nation in observing Healthy Aging Month in September, which raises awareness of the physical and mental health of older adults. WHEREAS, Chatham County Aging Services operates the Pittsboro Center for Active Living and the Siler City Center for Active Living to serve the physical, social and informational needs of those 55 years of age and older; and

WHEREAS, through the services, activities and programs of Chatham County Aging Services, a growing older adult population can contribute to its health and well-being and those of its fellow citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Pittsboro Center for Active Living and the Siler City Center for Active Living are staffed by caring professionals and volunteers who plan and provide programming affirming the dignity, self-worth and independence of the older adult population; and

WHEREAS, Chatham County Aging Services centers play a crucial role in preserving and maintaining the independence of older adults, allowing them to age in place for as long as possible; and

WHEREAS, the Pittsboro Center for Active Living and Siler City Center for Active Living have earned “Center of Excellence” distinctions from the North Carolina Division of Aging and Adult Services; and

WHEREAS, Chatham County Aging Services will commemorate Healthy Aging Month with its third annual Healthy Aging Expo on Tuesday, September 22 at Chatham County Agriculture & Conference Center.
