I am writing on behalf of the Chatham County Board of Commissioners to express our heartfelt congratulations to Pittsboro Presbyterian for earning its certification as an Earth Care Congregation through the Hunger Program of the Presbyterian Church USA. We know that this designation required years of diligent hard work by the church's Eco-Justice team to earn the points required.

The Earth Care Congregation designation means that your church is committed to integrating environmental practices and thinking in all facets of church life and has completed projects and activities in fields of worship, education, outreach and facilities. We know that solar panels recently were installed on the church, which we believe makes Pittsboro Presbyterian the first church in the county to do so.

The Earth Care Congregation designation has only been given to 233 Presbyterian churches out of approximately 9,000 around the nation, which indicates just how coveted the designation is.

The Chatham County Board of Commissioners has made clean, smart energy part of our 25-Year Comprehensive Plan.
