

THE PLAN

Through increasing teacher access to resources, targeted staff development and community collaboration, we are aiming to improve health outcomes.

CATCH

Coordinated Approach to Child Health

All K-8 Physical Education teachers have access to new Physical Education Curriculum that includes social and emotional learning, as well as healthful living concepts.

CANVAS

Learning Management System

The Chatham County Schools utilizes Canvas, which is a Learning Management System. That allows teacher to utilized different methods of instruction to address the needs of our students. We are in the process of developing critical components of the Healthful Living curriculum to assure students throughout the district are engaged in similar instruction.

Increase Teacher Resources

Healthy Relationship Guidance

With support from the Chatham County Victim Services and the Chatham County Public Health Department, we are in the process of developing the curriculum and materials that teachers will use for their instruction around Healthy Relationships.

American Heart Association

We have collaborated with the American Heart
Association to enable the Physical Education
staff access to a range of resources made
available by the AHA. This includes
professional development, instructional and
employee wellness materials.

Vaping/Tobacco Education

With support from the Chatham County Public Health Department, we have implemented a resource from the Truth Initiative that serves as a tobacco cessation tool for students, as well as an educational campaign. This information has been distributed throughout the district in various methods. In addition, an alternative to suspension program is being developed to help students that have violated the CCS tobacco policy with an educational and interactive program.

Operation Prevention

Opioid Prevention Materials

We have produced an online professional development that is accessible to all CCS staff. This opportunity includes information about addiction and opioid abuse, as well as materials for classroom instruction on prevention.

ACEs

Adverse Childhood Experiences

The Physical Education staff have received professional development on Adverse Childhood Experiences. This instruction included the impacts of ACEs on mental health and long term physical health implications.

Increase Staff Development

Physical Education & Healthful Living Integration

In an attempt to streamline make instruction more efficient, we have worked with NC Health Schools to create a professional development that simultaneously incorporates the Physical Education essential standards with the Healthful Living essential standards.

OPEN

Online Physical Education Network is an organization that provides Professional Development for Physical Education teachers across the US. This organization provided the staff with innovative new instructional methods along with access to new curriculum.

CHAMPS

Conversation, Help, Activity, Movement, Participation and Success.

CHAMPS is a classroom behavior management system introduced to CCS employees. The goal is to develop an instructional structure in which students are responsible, motivated, and highly engaged in the specific task at hand.
