




LCT2:

Phase One:

- Phased LCT2 Flood Mitigation Project map with Stream Segments included.
- The area will include parks, trails, and sidewalks.
- StRAP Grant \$500,000
 Segments 1 & 4 of Phase 1.
- PARTF Grant for Acquisition \$500,000 Parcel P16166 1st parcel to be acquired.





LOVES CREEK GREENWAY:

Facility Amenities:

• 1.4 Mile Paved Path.

- Develop a planning study (10% design/engineering) for a multi-modal infrastructure project for Phases 2 and 3 of the Loves Creek Greenway.
- Phase 2 Construct ~ 0.8-mile multi-use path. From Loves Creek Greenway/Pony Farm Rd. to US 64 (E. 11th St.)
- Phase 3 Construct ~ 0.4-mile multi-use path. From SR 2208 (S. 2nd Ave.) to SR 2113 (S. Chatham Ave.)






ERNEST RAMSEY GYMNASIUM:

- Paved Walking Track.
- Permanent Restroom Facility.
- Land Acquisition.






BOLING LANE PARK:

- A plan to repair the buffer as designed and constructed by ESP Associates.
- Working collaboratively with Chatham Soil & Water and Loves Creek Watershed Stewards (LCWS).


BRAY PARK SPORTS COMPLEX:


