- WHEREAS, Kenzie Wrenn Scoggins, a five-year-old resident of Siler City, Chatham County, North Carolina, was diagnosed on December 8, 2021 with an aggressive brain tumor called Childhood Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG); and

- **WHEREAS,** Kenzie Wrenn Scoggins underwent numerous treatments, tests, and appointments over nine months as she courageously fought for her young life; and
- WHEREAS, Kenzie Wrenn Scoggins passed away on September 18, 2022, in the comfort of her home; and
- **WHEREAS**, "A Bushel and a Peck" by Doris Day was Kenzie's favorite song, and December 17 is Kenzie's birthday.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Chatham County Board of Commissioners proclaims December 17, 2022, as "Bushel & A Peck Day" in Chatham County in remembrance of Kenzie Wrenn Scoggins and to raise awareness of DIPG.
