**WHEREAS**, Jordan Wiley was selected to represent Chatham County at the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners (NCACC) 100 Strong Productions Student Film Festival, held on April 25, 2026, in Cary, North Carolina; and

**WHEREAS**, Jordan’s participation in the NCACC Student Film Festival exemplifies the creativity, talent, and promise of Chatham County’s youth and brings positive recognition to the county on a statewide platform.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Chatham County Board of Commissioners hereby recognize and commend Jordan Wiley for his outstanding achievement in student filmmaking, his dedication to storytelling and historical preservation, and his exemplary representation of Chatham County at the 2026 NCACC 100 Strong Productions Student Film Festival; and
