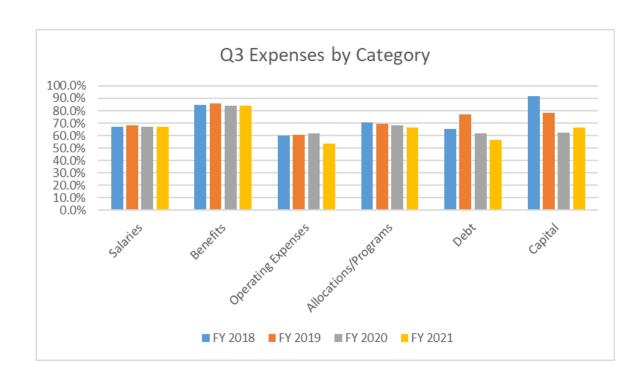
Background

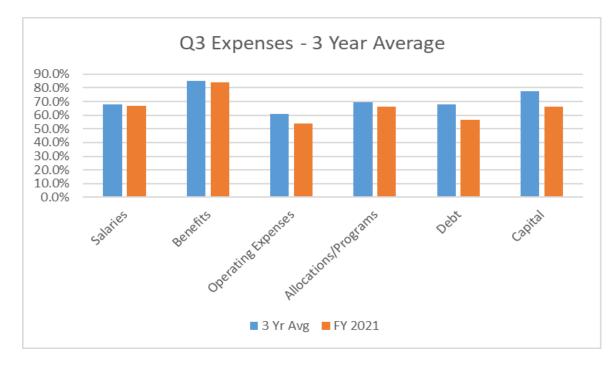
- Includes revenues and expenditures for the first 9 months of the fiscal year (July March)
- Is a high-level overview not a line item level review
- Does not include:
 - Interest Revenue
 - Transfers In or Out
 - Appropriated Fund Balance
- Only 6 months of sales tax data due to lag between collection by the State and disbursement to counties.
- Compares Revenue/Expenses by category and budget function
- Compares 3rd quarter current year to 3rd quarter for each of last 3 fiscal years and an average of those years.

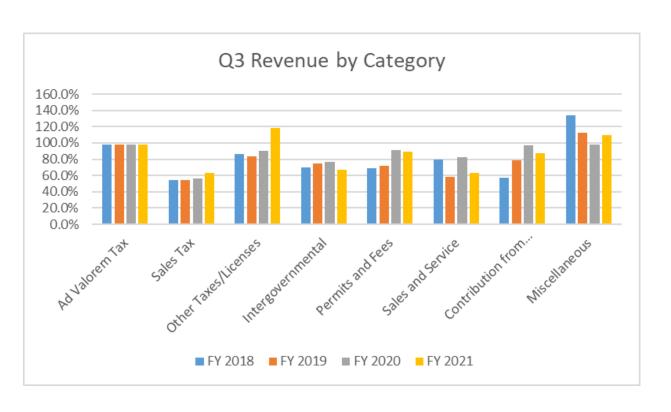

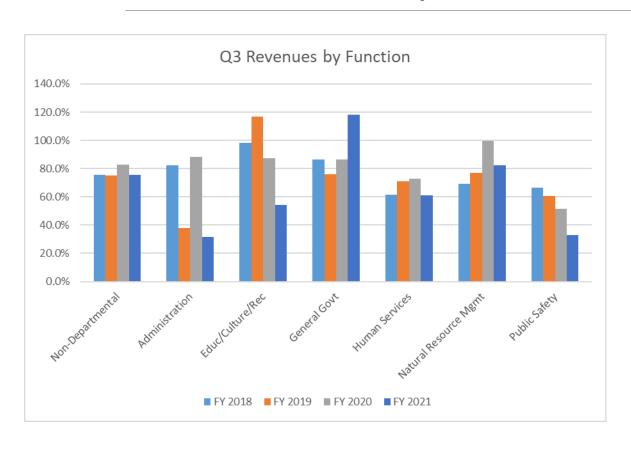

A Note on Revenues

- Development Services continues to operate at a rapid pace in Chatham County!
- Register of Deeds excise tax revenues up significantly over last year
- Inspections continues to operate at a brisk pace – approximately 10% ahead of last year on number of inspections performed

- The Ad Valorem revenue, which is our largest single source of revenue, continues to operate ahead of last year (+0.6%)
- We are on track to make budget in our Ad Valorem revenue category.
- Motor Vehicle tax, another ad valorem revenue, is performing above last year (+500k/+13% over the same time last year)

Sales Tax update

- Through 6 months, sales tax collection is at just over \$9.2 million
- We are ahead of last year by approximately \$1.7 million a 19% increase over the same time period
- For the year, we are at 63% of budget collected, ahead of the same time last year (56%)
- Collections in all but one month in FY21 has exceeded the same month in FY20

Article 46 Sales Tax

- Article 46 revenues have officially started coming into the County with the Month 4 disbursement.
- Reminder we budgeted \$968,111 in Article 46 sales tax funds in FY21
 - This was budgeted to offset the increase in the Schools supplement due to retirement/benefits increases
- Collections through 4 months: \$821,792
- If we maintain this pace, total collections would equal approximately \$1.6 million
- Staff will keep the Board updated on Article 46 status
 - If we exceed budget, will need guidance on use of additional Article 46 funds
