

**Project Ordinance Concerning
Siler City Center for Active Living Renovations**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Board of the County of Chatham, North Carolina that pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following capital project ordinance is hereby amended:

Section 1. The project authorized consists of renovations to improve programming space and create additional office space. This will also include new flooring, paint and ceiling tiles throughout the building.

Section 2. The County Manager is hereby directed to proceed with the capital project with the authority to sign all contracts and change orders within the terms of the budget contained herein.

Section 3. The following amounts are appropriated for the project:

Design & Administration	75,000	-10,100	64,900
Construction Miscellaneous Contracts	25,000	-19,854	5,146

Section 4. The following revenue is anticipated to be available to complete this project:

Transfer In - General	750,000	21,386	771,386

Section 5. The County Manager is directed to include a detailed analysis of past and future costs and revenues on this capital project in every budget submission made to this Board.

Section 6. Copies of this capital project ordinance shall be furnished to the Clerk to the Governing Board, and to the County Manager and Finance Officer for direction in carrying out this project.
