Resolution of the Chatham County Board of Commissioners Approving the Interlocal Agreement with Town of Siler City

WHEREAS, Article 20 of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes authorizes Chatham County (the "County") to enter into undertakings with one or more other units of local government; and

WHEREAS, one of the three Community Health Impact Priorities identified by the Chatham Health Alliance based on the results from the 2024 Community Assessment is increasing activities for youth and young adults, with a goal of improving mental, emotional, and social health for this population in the county; and

WHEREAS, the Chatham County Public Health Department has Healthy Communities grant funds budgeted for fiscal year 25-26 for a feasibility study and other park design expenses for developing a new park space in Siler City at the Bray Park Complex that will be designed specifically for ages 14-25; and

WHEREAS, the feasibility study will incorporate the results of a youth survey conducted in the fall of 2026 and prioritize engagement with the community, specifically adolescents and young adults, to plan park features and elements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chatham County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the attached "Interlocal Agreement" ("Agreement") with the Town of Siler City and authorizes the Public Health Director to execute the Agreement attached hereto and to provide such notices and take such actions as Agreement contemplates.
