Improved economic stability for low/moderate income adults




Improved outcomes for children/youth living in poverty




Improved access to comprehensive health care

Funding level increased to \$250,000 in FY20 and has remained at this amount.




At FY22 Budget Retreat, Commissioners requested staff identify a method to allow annual allocation to increase over time to meet community needs as county continues to grows.






FY23 Operating Budget Process begins in January




FY23 Nonprofit Allocation Funds announced in January for a February application period.

Human services nonprofit annual allocation to be upwardly adjusted by the same percentage of the County's year-over-year Ad Valorem tax base percentage increase.
