NCSU ITRE Microtransit Study

Chatham Transit Network Executive Director Anna Testermann presented an update on a potential micro transit program.

Testermann stated that the program is a flexible, on-demand public transportation service that bridges the gap between traditional fixed-route buses and private ride-hailing services like Uber and Lyft.

Testermann stated that the proposed pilot programs for the towns would including the Town of Siler City would have two vehicles running Monday through Saturday and the Town of Pittsboro would have one new vehicle running Monday through Saturday, with times to be determined.

Testermann shared the cost estimate and answered questions of the Board of Commissioners.

The Board of Commissioners asked questions of Testerman concerning the number and size of vehicles, electronic vehicles, and timing of the program.
