County staff presented goals around school construction and renovation, broadband barriers, replacing the economic tier system, protecting the property tax base, improving water quality, protecting local control, increase in funding for aging services, supporting the creation of a state housing tax credit, and support of affordable housing.

Dr. Jackson reviewed goals for Chatham County public schools. Mayor Perry presented goals for the Town of Pittsboro. Assistant Manager Thompson reviewed the Economic Tier System and how it negatively impacts the Town of Siler City and residents in the western part of the county.
