JOINT MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND BOARD OF EDUCATION

SCHEDULE FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (SCHOOL ROOF REPLACEMENTS)

A 2010 Roof Assessment identified roofs at a number of school facilities needing replacement. These roofs are being replaced over a period of several years using funding from both QSCB (Qualified School Construction Bond) and County funding sources. Prior to FY 2017, seven roofing projects were completed.

School and County administration have established a plan to replace the remaining roofs as follows:

FY 2017: Chatham Central High School and North Chatham Elementary (contracts awarded to Hamlin Roofing)

FY 2018: Maintenance, Perry Harrison Elementary and Siler City Elementary (design work scheduled to begin in July of 2017)

FY 2019: Jordan-Matthews High School and Northwood High School

NEW HIGH SCHOOL UPDATES

- > 75 acres of land have been purchased on Seaforth Road (Chatham County Schools Future School sign has been erected)
- The contract for Architectural Services has been awarded (design work to be completed in July 2018). Initial design meetings to address school areas have been completed.
- Board of Education approved beginning contract negotiations for Geotechnical Services, Surveying Services, and Commissioning Services during the March 20, 2017 meeting.
- Wastewater sub-surface tests are in progress; Traffic Impact Analysis and Survey (boundaries and topography) are complete.
- Preliminary approval for the two points of access to Seaforth Road has been given by the Army Corps of Engineers and will be finalized once the campus design is finished.
- > The current schedule supports an August, 2021 opening for students.



NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL UPDATES

- A 25+ acre site on the corner of Andrews Store Road and Parker Herndon Road is under contract (due diligence is underway)
- Property closing is pending current Briar Chapel CUP modification submission.
- An architect has been selected (contract negotiations are in progress)
- The Board of Education approved beginning contract negotiations for Geotechnical Services, Surveying Services, and Commissioning Services at their March 20, 2017 meeting.
- A traffic impact analysis has been completed.
- The current schedule supports an August, 2020 opening for students.

OTHER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS <u>APPROVED PROJECTS</u>

Bleacher Replacement (Indoor)

Renovate and/or install new bleachers at J.S. Waters, Moncure, & Horton Middle in FY 2019

Joint School Bus and County Garage

> This facility is the first of its kind in North Carolina. Operational, close-out in progress

Locker Room Renovations

Renovate locker rooms at Jordan-Matthews, Chatham Central, Northwood, Moncure, and J.S. Waters schools beginning FY 2018

Mobile Classrooms

Purchase modular classrooms to alleviate overcrowding at schools as space as needed

New Central Services Building

2014 Facility Condition Assessment indicates that the existing Central Services Building has exceeded its capacity and intended lifespan. Projected opening in FY 2023.



OTHER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS <u>APPROVED PROJECTS</u>

Northwood High School Auditorium HVAC Replacement

Contract executed to replace the HVAC (Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning) system during FY 2018. Project expected to be complete by the opening of school in the fall of 2017

Northwood High School Paving Overlay

Repair potholes and cracks in the pavement at Northwood High School during FY 2019

Perry Harrison Elementary School Traffic Pattern

Improve the traffic pattern at Perry Harrison Elementary during FY 2019

Wastewater Replacement at Silk Hope School

Replace current wastewater system located partially on privately owned property with a more efficient, on-site system during FY 2023



OTHER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS <u>FUTURE PROJECTS</u>

HVAC/Lighting Replacement

Replace outdated and inefficient HVAC and lighting systems with up-to-date, energy efficient systems as recommended in 2014 Facility Condition Assessment

New Schools/Capacity Expansion

Construct new schools, build additions at existing schools, and/or place modular classrooms as most feasible.

Paving Repair

Repair paving on all campuses

Replace Gymnasiums at Bennett, Silk Hope and Bonlee Schools

It will be more economical to replace these gymnasiums (1951 construction) than to renovate
