RESOLUTION OF THE ALAMANCE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS CONFIRMING THAT IF THE VOTERS OF THE COUNTY APPROVE A ONE-QUARTER CENT (1/4 cent) COUNTY SALES AND USE TAX THE ANNUAL REVENUE PRODUCED THEREBY SHALL BE USED FOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the Alamance County Board of Commissioners has by resolution called for a November 6, 2018 special advisory referendum concerning the levy of a one-quarter cent (1/4) county sales and use tax; and

WHEREAS, the Alamance County Board of Commissioners recognizes the need for revenue to support and enhance education and training programs in the County; and

WHEREAS, the levy of Article 46 one-quarter cent (1/4 cent) County sales and use tax would provide an incremental source of revenue to Alamance County in the amount of approximately \$4,800,000 annually;

NOW, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE ALAMANCE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

The revenue from the Article 46 one-quarter cent (1/4) County sales and use tax to support and enhance education and training programs in the County.
