Action Requested: Motion to surplus weapon and award the service weapon to Lieutenant Joe Birchett on the event of his retirement from the Chatham County Sheriff's Office.

Introduction & Background: Lieutenant Joe Birchett has served over 27 years with the county.

Discussion & Analysis: In the past, on the event of a long serving, sworn officer's retirement, their assigned service weapon, Glock 9mm, model 17, has been surplused and presented to them upon their retirement.
