Introduction & Background: Carolina Civilworks will construct a chemical booster station at the County's Hwy 902 Pump Station.

Discussion & Analysis: The chemical booster station will increase the chloramine concentration of water supplied by the City of Sanford and pumped to Chatham County's Southwest Water System and Siler City.
