Vote on Request to approve the contract with Waste Management and to authorize the County Manager to execute the contract.

Action Requested: Vote on Request to approve the contract with Waste Management and to authorize the County Manager to execute the contract.

Introduction & Background: Compactor and bulky containers are taken from some of the Collection Centers and hauled to Waste Management Transfer Station in Sanford and Great Oak Landfill in Randolph County.

Discussion & Analysis: The majority of the municipal solid waste (MSW) tonnage is taken to Great Oak Landfill in Randolph County. The transfer station of Sanford and Durham are used as alternate disposal locations because they are closer to some of the Collection Centers from the landfill, there is usually less wait time and less wear and tear on the trucks. We sign agreements every fiscal year specifying the cost per ton at each disposal location.

How does this relate to the Comprehensive Plan: Become more resilient by mitigating, responding, and adapting to emerging threats.

Budgetary Impact: Cost per ton \$57.59 for Waste Management Transfer Station and \$42.76 per ton for Great Oak Landfill is included in the operating budget.

Recommendation: Approve the contract with Waste Management and authorize the County Manager to execute the contract to commence on July 1, 2022.
