Vote to adopt a resolution for the Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Pittsboro for landscaping and grounds maintenance of the Historic Courthouse Circle

Introduction & Background: North Carolina General Statute 160A-461 authorizes units of local government to enter interlocal agreements with each other to execute any undertaking and allows the participating units to determine the reasonable duration of the agreements and requires that interlocal agreements be ratified by resolution of the governing board of each participating unit, and the resolution spread upon the minutes of the governing board.

Discussion & Analysis: The County and the Town desire to enter into an agreement to allow the Town to landscape and maintain the grounds of the Chatham County Historic Courthouse and within the Courthouse Circle.

How does this relate to the Comprehensive Plan: Although a goal is not identified in Plan Chatham, this partnership will help increase the esthetics of the county property in downtown Pittsboro.

Budgetary Impact: No additional budgeted funds will be required.
