Vote on a request to approve a Resolution for the Water Shortage Response Plans for the North Chatham, Asbury and Southwest water systems.

Action Requested: Vote on a request to approve a Resolution for the Water Shortage Response Plans for the North Chatham, Asbury and Southwest water systems.

Introduction & Background: Water Shortage Response Plans are required by North Carolina General Statue 143-355 (I) to be approved by Resolution of the proper governing body every 5 years.

Discussion & Analysis: These plans are written to reduce potable water demand and supplement existing drinking water supplies whenever existing water supply sources are inadequate to meet current demands for potable water. No changes were required to be made and these plans have already been reviewed and approved by North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality.

How does this relate to the Comprehensive Plan: Conserve natural resources.
