
Safe Kids Chatham Program Review

- Saturday Car Seat Check location
- 6 CPS Techs trained
- 23 Diversion Program virtual participants



Safe New Drivers Education

- 225 Chatham and Chapel Hill-Carrboro high school students
- Best Practices and Effective Strategies to Reduce Risk:
 - Seat belt use
 - Number of passengers
 - Time/weather/day of the week
 - Safest vehicle
 - Substance use and distraction small group discussions



Home Safety Partnership

- Cable Gun Locks
- Lock Boxes
- Medication Disposal Bags
- Narcan Kits
- Cabinet locks; baby gates; non-slip appliques; doorknob covers; spout covers

Partners:

- Chatham County Public Health-Newborn Postpartum Home Visiting
- Future pediatric provider pilot



Gun Safety, Mental Health, and Suicide Prevention

- Resource for cable gun locks and public sites along with gun safety education
- BE SMART; Local Mental Health resources; National Suicide 988 Hotline; Crisis Text line; Good Samaritan 911; Overdose info





Overdose Prevention/Safe Disposal

- Operation Medicine Drops/National DEA Take Back Days
- Outreach events
- Support permanent drop boxes
- Provide lock boxes and chemical med disposal bags through home safety partnerships

Water Safety

- Jordan Lake education outreach
- Public PFDs
- Increase swim/water safety class access



Fire Safety



Annual October education outreach through Fire Marshal and local fire departments



Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety

- Bike rodeos and education
- Bike helmets
- Walk/Bike to Schools
