


#### About the Alliance

- To bring organizations and residents together to work on issues affecting health in Chatham County, with a focus on the health priorities identified in the Community Assessment.








#### Chatham Health Alliance Structure



Community Resource Hub, Youth Voices of Chatham, Chatham Moves Physical Activity Trailer



#### Community Resource Hub

A mobile co-location of free Chatham County resources and information.

- Operating Since 2020
- Main Program Team: Sara Martin, Chatham Health Alliance and Travis Patterson, SEEDS
- Ongoing partnership with the Interfaith Food Shuttle
- At least one Hub a month held in various locations
- Resources include:
  - Hot meals
  - CORA food boxes
  - Vaccines
  - Car Seats
  - Medication Lock Boxes and Disposal Kits

The Hub connects service providers and resources directly to community members.

By going directly into neighborhoods, we are able to establish relationships and trust with the community.

#### Youth Voices of Chatham

A county-wide youth led advisory and leadership group.

- Partnership between the Alliance, CORE, SEEDS, Chatham County Schools, and Hispanic Liaison
- Three focus areas are social justice, community service, and civic engagement
- Power of Youth, youth leader training launched on May 20th
- Second part of YES! Training will focus on recruitment and retention
- Summer meeting to strategic plan for 2023-2024 school year
- Vision, Mission, and Core Values Developed

#### Chatham Moves Physical Activity Trailer

A mobile trailer bringing equipment and physical activity programming throughout Chatham County
